Step 1: ADMISSION & MESA SCHOLARSHIP

- Fill out the University of the Pacific admission application at go.pacific.edu/apply and email this MESA Scholarship Application to epeachfine@pacific.edu.
- If you are applying to the University of the Pacific as a first-year student, you are required to take either the SAT-I or the ACT, you may self-report your scores on the application.

Step 2: FINANCIAL AID

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- ¥ To apply for financial aid, you'll need to file a 2020-21 FAFSA. The FAFSA is available October 1.
- ¥ E-sign your FAFSA using your FSA ID. If you don't already have an FSA ID you can create one when logging into <https://studentaid.ed.gov/>.
- ¥ Complete the FAFSA online or on your mobile device at <https://studentaid.ed.gov/>.
- ¥ The FAFSA is available in English and Spanish.
